



EXHIBITION HALLS

A wide variety of restored locomotives and rolling stock is on display. The selection includes the superb royal coaches of the Russian Emperors, the Heritage Train Valtteri and many other interesting items.

ENGINE ROUNDHOUSE

Here the visitor can experience the genuine atmosphere of an engine shed. The roundhouse contains locomotives dating from different eras and shows a repair shop of yesteryear. The children's workshop is situated at the far end of the building.

STATION BUILDING

The wooden station building of the former Hyvinkää–Hanko private railway has been restored to its former 1873 condition. The interior has typical facilities such as booking office and waiting rooms for general public and upper-class ladies.

BARRACKS

A building formerly used to house railway families, known as the barracks, presents the development of the railway network in Finland. There is also a display of uniforms and a presentation of railway occupations.

SUMMER CAFÉ

The small and cozy summer café sells refreshments and snacks during the summer season. The café is situated in the former bakery cottage where railway workers and their families baked bread and other pastries in the olden days.

ENTRANCE

The ticket and sales desk, public conveniences, and museum shop for souvenirs and books are situated at the entrance. Coffee can be enjoyed here when the summer café is closed.
